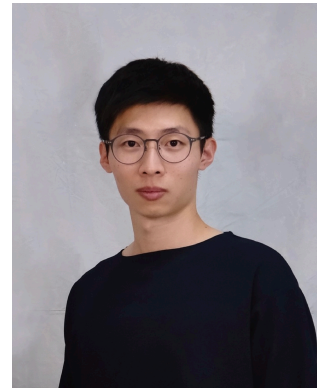


WU Wei Ting
